Information for Scholarship Applicants

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist graduating high school seniors and college students in financing his or her college education.

BACKGROUND

Created in 1999, the Wisconsin PGA Junior Foundation is a 501 (c) 3 organization dedicated to the mission of providing opportunities for young people to learn life skills, and experience the enjoyment and education provided through the game of golf.

Since 1999, the WPGA Junior Foundation has administered over 80 annual junior golf tournaments, conducted 1,000's of free lessons and clinics, and awards annually over \$15,000 in scholarships and grants. Over 20,000 Junior Golfers participate each year.

In 2004, The First Tee of Milwaukee County officially became part of our WPGA Junior Foundation golf program. In the several years of operation, The First Tee has introduced thousands of kids from the Milwaukee area to the game and the wonderful lessons it teaches.

Wisconsin PGA Junior Foundation

Our mission at the WPGA Junior Foundation is to provide positive opportunities, enjoyment, and education to junior golfers. We accomplish this through tournaments, clinics, camps, academies, scholarships, grants, and other necessary vehicles to encourage and promote the game of golf. The Wisconsin PGA Junior Foundation provides extremely affordable golf lessons to juniors between the ages of 6-18. From the junior who has never touched a golf club, to the advanced player, the WPGA offers programs for every level player. Scholarships are available to kids not able to afford these programs.

The First Tee of Milwaukee County

The First Tee is a World Golf Foundation initiative dedicated to providing young people of all backgrounds an opportunity to develop, through golf and character education, life-enhancing values such as honesty, integrity and sportsmanship. The intent is to offer opportunities for improvement in the quality of life and create a platform where children can increase their potential for success. The First Tee of Milwaukee County provides free golf programs to the youth of Milwaukee County. Many of the kids in the First Tee programs would not have otherwise been introduced to the game of golf. Whether it's a financial issue or location relative to a golf course, the First Tee prides itself on working with all youth wanting to learn the game.

The WPGA Junior Foundation and The First Tee of Milwaukee County want to grow their programs by offering more instruction, enhanced programs at a wider number of facilities, throughout the Greater Milwaukee area. By teaming up to develop staff, raise awareness and offer more programs to a greater number of junior golfers, these programs are sure to make a positive impact on area youth.

High School Senior Scholarship Criteria

1. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior
2. Applicants must be high school seniors accepted to attend a full-time course of study at an accredited college or university in the United States.
3. Applicants must have participated in at least 3 WPGA Junior events or programs as a junior golfer.
4. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.2 (on a 4.0 scale), and a minimum of 20 on ACT test.
5. Applicants must have attended a Wisconsin High School for a minimum of four semesters.
6. Recipients must begin their college or university education within one calendar year of the date of high school graduation.
7. Children of employees of the WPGA Junior Foundation, Inc. WPGA Section Office and WPGA Golf Services are not eligible for the scholarship.
8. Selection is based on scholastic achievement, contributions to school and community, moral character, personality, initiative, citizenship and leadership. Consideration may also be given for outstanding character displayed at WPGA junior events or programs.

High School Senior Application Criteria

1. Completed WPGA Junior Foundation Scholarship Application
2. Official High School Transcript
3. An essay written by the applicant must accompany each application describing their experiences in WPGA Junior events or programs. (*Please limit to no more than 100-150 words*).
4. Two letters of recommendation from any of the following individuals are required and must accompany the completed application form:
 - (a) High school coach, PGA Professional, Employer, High School Teacher, Counselor or Principal; and or person in your community.

(a) College coach, PGA Professional, Employer, College Professor, Counselor; and or person in your community.
5. Selection is based on scholastic achievement, contributions to school and community, moral character, personality, initiative, citizenship and leadership.
