## **\*\*New for 2011\*\***

**Parent/Junior Tournament:** We have added a Parent/Junior tournament this year. The event will be held on June 12 at South Hills G&CC in Fond du Lac. The format is an 18-hole BestBall with Gross and Net Divisions. This is a fun event for a parent to participate with a son or daughter and enjoy a fun day of golf. Check out the entry form in this calendar of tournaments.

**Additional Best Ball event:** Because the best ball event has grown in popularity we have added another site this year. The Bull at Pinehurst Farms will host on July 5. The new best ball event added will be at Old Hickory Golf Course on July 14. Event at The Bull will be members only event.

**Member only events:** Only junior members will be allowed to register for Whistling Straits - Irish Course. This event will be limited to 100 participants and cost \$70. The Best Ball event at The Bull at Pinehurst farms will also be a members only event. Both team members must be junior members to participate.

**Non-member Online Registration:** All non-members will be allowed to register online for tournaments.

After May 11, all non-members may register online for tournaments. Beginning April 27, members will be able to register online for events. Members registering on-line prior to May 11, will be guaranteed entry into all but one of their selections.

## **Reminders for 2011**

### **Electronic Measuring Devices:**

These devices will now be allowed in Junior Tour, Players Tour, PGA Junior Championship, Lake Arrowhead Invitational, Best-Ball and Fall Stroke Play events. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might effect play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used. Yardage obtained from these devices may be shared with fellow competitors and is not deemed to be advice.

### **Players Tour Handicap requirements:**

The Players Tour is by invite ONLY. To be invited to play on the Players Tour, you must have a qualifying WSGA handicap. Boys must be under an 8.1 index and Girls must be under an 18.1 index. If you meet the above handicap requirements, contact Andy Landenberger or Bill Ehn at the Wisconsin PGA Section office to verify your handicap and be eligible to register for events on Players Tour. Players Tour entry form is now included in this calendar.

## Wisconsin PGA Golf Camp

The Wisconsin PGA Golf Camp is a co-educational golf camp open to all male and female junior golfers ages 11-17 (with exceptions). The sessions will be held at SentryWorld in Stevens Point, Wisconsin.

SentryWorld Golf Camp will be held June 26<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup>. Attendees will be staying at the UW Stevens Point dorm rooms. Individuals may sign up to room with another camper. SentryWorld is a par-72 6,951 course designed by world famous golf architect Robert Trent Jones II. It has been named as one of the top 25 public golf courses in the country and rated at four and a half stars by Golf Digest. SentryWorld hosted the State Senior Open in 2005 and 2006 Wisconsin vs. Minnesota Junior Cup matches.

Tuition is \$675 per student for the five day camp. Tuition includes:

- At least 18 holes of golf daily
- All practice range fees
- Video analysis of swing
- Daily featured clinician
- Daily instruction by PGA Professionals with 1 instructor to 4 student ratio
- Three meals daily
- Lodging at UW Stevens Point dorm rooms provided
- Transportation to and from golf course
- Welcome gift

Instruction Program: The instruction program, which is designed for intermediate or advanced skill levels, emphasizes course management, shot making, ball striking and the mental game. Instruction will be in the following areas: **Practice Range** - Grip, set-up, and swing techniques are taught. Various drills are conducted and their purposes are fully explained. **Short Game** - Instruction in this area emphasizes putting, chipping and various pitching strokes and bunker play. **Golf Course** - Instructors teach course management and how to play the game of golf through on-course playing and drills.

### How Do you Register?

Registrations are accepted on a first-come basis. There is a limit of 28 students for camp. You can find application on [www.wiscjuniorgolf.com](http://www.wiscjuniorgolf.com) under Golf Camp. Print application from website and mail or fax to WPGA Office.

# WPGA JUNIOR TOUR RULES AND REGULATIONS

## HOW DO I ENTER?

Complete the Junior Tour Entry Application by following the guidelines below. Junior members can register on-line at [www.wiscjuniorgolf.com](http://www.wiscjuniorgolf.com) starting April 27. Non-members may register online starting May 11. **INCOMPLETE OR ILLEGIBLE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.**

## ENTRY:

\$35 (members) \$40 (non-members) per event must accompany entry blank. This includes green fees, lunch, and awards. Juniors are limited to participating in **14 WPGA Junior Tour events**. Keeping in mind that many events fill to capacity, you may wish to check more than 14 events, in hope of getting in at least 14 events. If requesting more than 14 entries, please rank them in order of your preference with 1 being the event you would most like to compete. You will then be entered into the first open events based on your priority ranking. It is not necessary to write separate checks for each event entered.

## ELIGIBILITY:

Wisconsin residents or members of a club in the Wisconsin Section PGA, age 18 or under on the day of the tournament. **JUNIORS ARE ELIGIBLE TO PLAY IN A MAXIMUM OF 14 WPGA JUNIOR TOUR and PLAYERS TOUR EVENTS COMBINED.**

## FORMAT:

18-hole stroke play. Eight divisions as follows: Boys 16-18, Boys 14-15, Boys 12-13, Girls 16-18, Girls 14-15, Girls 12-13. The top 3 finishers will be awarded in the boys & girls 16-18 year old divisions. One champion and runner-up will be awarded for all other divisions. If less than four contestants are entered in any age division, contestants will move up to the next age bracket. Age on the day of the event determines division.

## LOTTERY DRAWING:

Non-member entries may be sent in at any time, but will not be processed until May 11. For events with less than 128 entries received, as of May 11, all players will be entered into the field. For events with more than 128 entries, as of May 11, a random drawing will determine the playing field. Entries will continue to be accepted until the deadline of each event. If the event is filled, the entry will be placed on the waiting list.

## DEADLINE:

Deadlines vary by event. The field will be closed at 128 players or the event deadline, whichever comes first. Late entries will not be accepted. Entries and checks must be in the WPGA office by 5:00 p.m. the day of the deadline. MasterCard and Visa entries are allowed but will incur a one time \$10 non-refundable service charge. (waived for jr. members registering on-line.) In the event the tournament entry limit is met, a waiting list will be formed. You must be on the waiting list in order to play as an alternate.

## REFUNDS:

**NO REFUNDS** after the entry deadline. If you cancel prior to deadline a \$10 cancellation fee will be charged. If an event is cancelled in its entirety, refunds will be issued. You may now cancel online using BlueGolf. If less than five holes are completed, refunds will be given on a pro-rated basis (entry less expenses). If five or more holes are completed, awards will be given out based on participant's score against par for the holes played and no refunds will be made. Points will only be awarded for events that complete all 18 holes.

# WPGA JUNIOR TOUR RULES AND REGULATIONS

## SPECTATOR GUIDELINES:

Spectators are welcome and encouraged to attend tournaments. Rules for spectators are as follows:

1. **No spectator will be allowed to use golf cars for any reason.**
2. **Spectators are required to stay in the rough or on the cart paths and 15 yards away from the players.**
3. **Spectators are allowed to carry water, umbrellas, jackets, towels and food for the players.**
4. **Spectators are not allowed to give advice to the players. Violation will result in penalty or disqualification. Violations will result in removal from future WPGA Tour events.**
5. **Players shall not carry on conversations with spectators. This action could be construed as ADVICE. Players will be penalized for a violation.**
6. **Cell phone or similar devices used on the golf course is prohibited. First violation will result in a 2 stroke penalty for the player, the second violation will be disqualification**

**Players will be responsible for the actions of their spectators.**

## CARE FOR THE GOLF COURSE:

All players are expected to maintain the golf course by replacing divots, repairing ball marks, raking bunkers, etc. Any abuse to the course or other club facilities will result in immediate disqualification. All players and parents are also encouraged to thank the host club, staff and volunteers for their support of the WPGA Junior Tour.

## PLAYER CONDUCT: NEW RULE STARTED IN 2009

Any conduct that may be detrimental to the Wisconsin PGA Junior Tour will not be tolerated including but not limited to swearing, club throwing, or damage to the golf course or another player's belongings. Penalty for breach of this rule is one stroke. Any incident worse may lead to two-stroke penalty or disqualification. Possession of alcohol or tobacco products, gambling, and display of vulgar or abusive behavior will result in immediate disqualification. Violations may result in removal from future WPGA Junior Tour events. Quitting or walking off the golf course during a round will not be tolerated. All players **MUST** turn in their scorecard when the round is completed.

## CELL PHONE USE:

The use of cellular phones during the play of any WPGA Junior Tour event will not be permitted. The penalty for the first violation will be 2 strokes for the player. The second violation will result in disqualification.

## RULES VIOLATIONS AND CHEATING:

Rules violations will be determined by the tournament officials and handled as prescribed by the USGA Rules of Golf, Junior Tour Director and the Executive Director of the Wisconsin PGA.

If you are suspected of cheating, measures will be taken to monitor your score during future Junior Tour events. If a player suspects another of cheating or of violating a rule of golf, the player should seek a Rules official as soon as possible to handle the situation. Cheating is strictly prohibited. Cheating will result in immediate disqualification from the Junior Tour with no refund.

## ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES:

These devices will now be allowed in Junior Tour, Players Tour, PGA Junior Championship, Lake Arrowhead Invitational, Best-Ball and Fall Stroke Play events. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might effect play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used. Yardage obtained from these devices may be shared with fellow competitors and is not deemed to be advice.

## NO CARDS:

If a player leaves a tournament site and fails to turn in his/her scorecard without notifying the junior tour tournament coordinator or leaving a message in the golf shop the player will be penalized 20 points towards their player of the year point total.

## DRESS CODE:

Proper golf attire is required. Collared shirts will be required at all times when at any event site. No cutoffs, jeans or jean shorts, tank tops, or gym shorts allowed. Hats may be worn providing they are worn with the bill to the front. Metal spikes are not permitted. Players may wear shoes with non-metal spikes or tennis shoes.

## CADDIES/ADVICE:

Caddies are not permitted. Contestants must carry their own bag or use a pull cart. Outside advice is not allowed during competition play. Breach of rule – disqualification.

## WEATHER:

It is the responsibility of each contestant to contact the club where the event is to be played in the case of inclement weather or conditions that would warrant re-scheduling or cancellation of the tournament.

## POINTS:

Player of the Year points are based on overall finish against the full field for both Boys/Girls. Please reference WI Player of Year spreadsheet located on [www.wiscjuniorgolf.com](http://www.wiscjuniorgolf.com) for more information.

## PACE OF PLAY:

**WE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCING THE PACE OF PLAY POLICY THAT WAS IMPLIMENTED IN 2007. DETAILS WILL BE POSTED ONLINE AND AT EACH EVENT. IF A PLAYER IS UNABLE TO FINISH THE EVENT IN A TIMELY MANNER, AS A RESULT OF ABILITY OR COURSE CONDITIONS, THE PLAYER MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE EVENT. IN SUCH A CASE, A FULL REFUND WILL BE GIVEN FOR HIS/HER ENTRY FEE.**

## Net Events:

Look for junior tour events that will have a Gross and Net division. You must have a WSGA Handicap to be eligible for Net division. Net division is not broken into age divisions. Net Division winners will be determined by subtracting current handicap index by gross score. Our goal of these events is to reward juniors who play well based on their own ability. Any Gross division winner cannot win a Net division award.

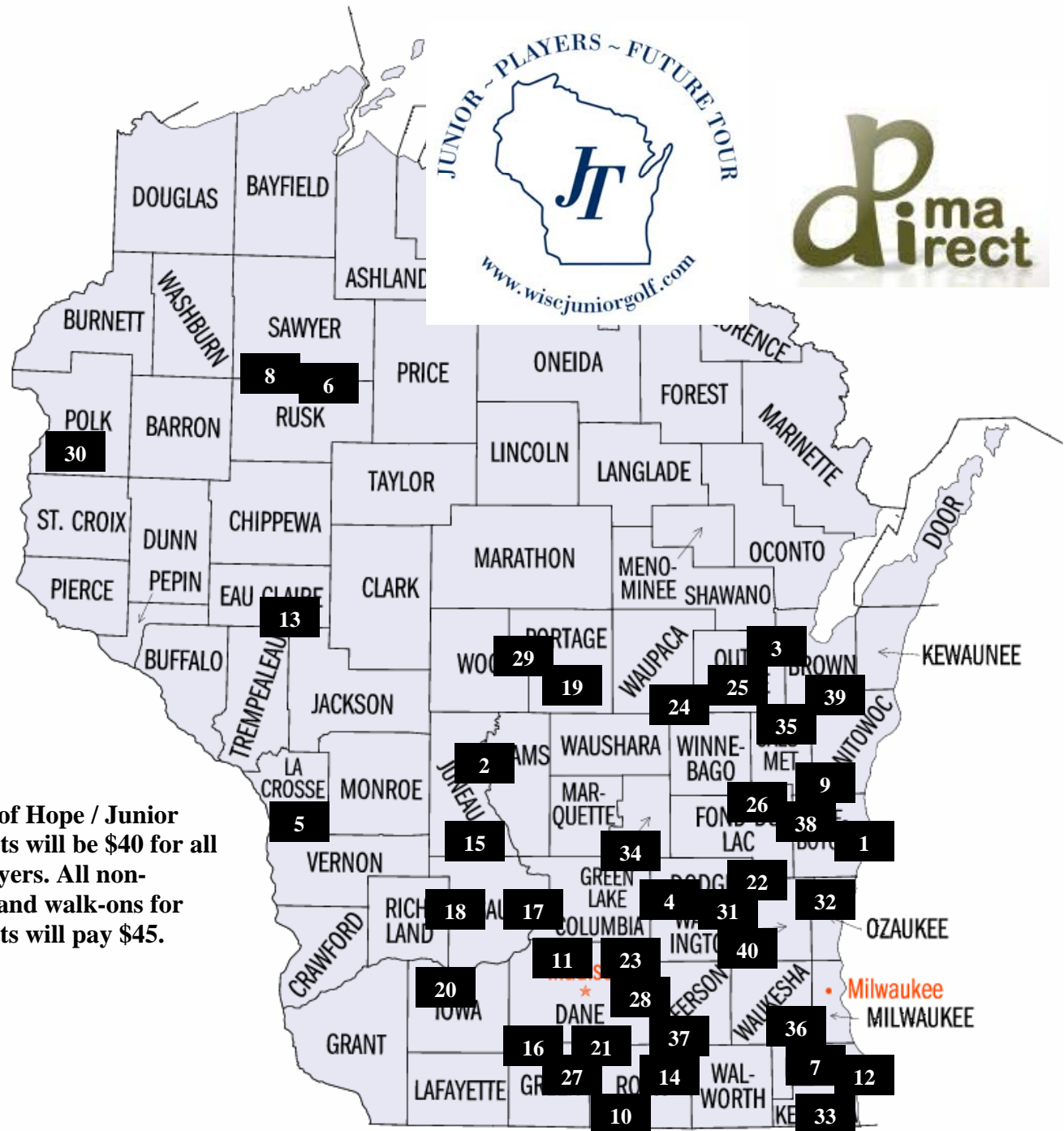

# WPGA JUNIOR FOUNDATION PLAYERS TOUR RULES AND REGULATIONS

## HOW DO I ENTER?

The Players Tour is by invite ONLY. To be invited to play in the Players Tour events, you must have a qualifying WSGA handicap. Boys must be under an 8.1 index and Girls must be under an 18.1 index. If you meet the above handicap requirements, contact Andy Landenberger or Bill Ehn at the Wisconsin PGA Section office to verify your handicap and be eligible to register for events the Players Tour.

## ENTRY:

Appropriate entry fees must accompany entry blank. Please account for the different rates for the 36 hole events. Fee includes green fees, range, lunch, and awards. **Juniors are limited to participating in a combined number of 14 Players Tour and Junior Tour events.** Juniors may play in all Players Tour events.

## ELIGIBILITY:

Wisconsin residents or members of a club in the Wisconsin Section PGA, age 18 or under on the day of the tournament. \*\*\*Players must have a qualifying WSGA handicap to participate on the Players Tour. Boys must be below an 8.1 index and girls must be below an 18.1 index to participate.

## FORMAT:

18-hole or 36-hole format. There are no age divisions for this tour. Players of all ages will be competing against one another for the top 8 prizes for boys and top 5 for girls.

## LOTTERY DRAWING:

Non-member entries may be sent in at any time, but will not be processed until May 11. For those events with more than field limit entries, as of May 11, a random drawing will determine the playing field. Entries will continue to be accepted until the deadline of each event. If the event is filled before the deadline, the entry will be placed on the waiting list.

## EXEMPTIONS:

The boy and girl leader in the player of the year points received from Players Tournaments will receive an exempt spot to play on Team Wisconsin in The 15<sup>th</sup> Annual WI-MN Cup Match in 2012.

## DEADLINE:

Deadlines vary by event. The field will set when it reaches its limit or event deadline, whichever comes first. Late entries will not be accepted. Entries and checks must be in the WPGA office by 5:00 p.m. the day of the deadline. MasterCard and Visa entries are allowed but will incur a one time \$10 non-refundable service charge (waived for members who register on-line). In the event the tournament entry limit is met, a waiting list will be formed.

## REFUNDS:

**NO REFUNDS** after the entry deadline. If you cancel prior to deadline a \$10 cancellation fee will be charged. If an event is cancelled in its entirety, refunds will be issued. **You may cancel online or by calling the office.**

If less than five holes are completed, refunds will be given on a pro-rated basis (entry less expenses). If five or more holes are completed, awards will be given out based on participant's score against par for the holes played and no refunds will be made. Points will only be awarded for events which complete all 18 holes.

## ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES:

These devices will now be allowed in Junior Tour, Players Tour, PGA Junior Championship, Lake Arrowhead Invitational, Best-Ball and Fall Stroke Play events. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might effect play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used. Yardage obtained from these devices may be shared with fellow competitors and is not deemed to be advice.

# Players Tour Rules and Regulations

## SPECTATOR GUIDELINES:

Spectators are welcome and encouraged to attend tournaments. Rules for spectators are as follows:

1. No spectator will be allowed to use golf cars for any reason.
2. Spectators are required to stay in the rough or on the cart paths and 15 yards away from the players.
3. Spectators are allowed to carry water, umbrellas, jackets, towels and food for the players.
4. Spectators are not allowed to give advice to the players. Violation will result in penalty or disqualification. Multiple violations will result in removal from future WPGA Tour Events.
5. Players shall not carry on conversations with spectators. This action could be construed as ADVICE. Players will be penalized for a violation.
6. Cell phone or similar devices use on the golf course is prohibited. First violation will result in a 2 stroke penalty for the player, the second violation will be disqualification
7. Players will be responsible for the actions of their spectators.

## CARE FOR THE GOLF COURSE:

All players are expected to maintain the golf course by replacing divots, repairing ball marks, raking bunkers, etc. Any abuse to the course or other club facilities will result in immediate disqualification. All players and parents are also encouraged to thank the host club, staff and volunteers for their support of the WPGA Players Tour.

## Player Conduct Rule:

Any conduct that may be detrimental to the Wisconsin PGA Players Tour will not be tolerated including but not limited to swearing, club throwing, or damage to the golf course or another player's belongings. (Example: Not replacing your divot or fixing ball mark can result in breach of conduct rule). Penalty for breach of this rule is one stroke. Any major infraction may lead to two-stroke penalty or disqualification. Possession of alcohol or tobacco products, gambling, and display of vulgar or abusive behavior will result in immediate disqualification. Violations may result in removal from future events. Quitting or walking off the golf course during a round will not be tolerated. All players MUST turn in their scorecard when the round is completed.

## CELL PHONE USE:

The use of cellular phones during the play of any WPGA Players Tour event will not be permitted. The penalty for the first violation will be 2 strokes for the player. The second violation will result in disqualification.

## RULES VIOLATIONS AND CHEATING:

Rules violations will be determined by the tournament officials and handled as prescribed by the USGA Rules of Golf, Junior Tour Director and the Executive Director of the Wisconsin PGA.

If you are suspected of cheating, measures will be taken to monitor your score during future Junior Tour events. If a player suspects another of cheating or of violating a rule of golf, the player should seek a rules official as soon as possible to handle the situation. Cheating is strictly prohibited. Cheating will result in immediate disqualification from the Junior Tour event with no refund.

## NO CARDS

If a player leaves a tournament site and fails to turn in his/her scorecard without notifying the junior tour tournament coordinator or leaving a message in the golf shop the player will be penalized 20 points towards their player of the year point total.

## SHOES/SPIKES:

Metal-Spikes are not permitted. Players may wear shoes with non-metal spikes or tennis shoes.

## DRESS CODE:

Proper golf attire is required. Collared shirts or will be required at all times when at any event site. No cutoffs, jeans or jean shorts, tank tops, or gym shorts allowed. Hats may be worn providing they are worn with the bill to the front.

## CADDIES/ADVICE:

Caddies are not permitted. Contestants must carry their own bag or use a pull cart. Outside advice is not allowed during competition play. Breach of rule – disqualification.

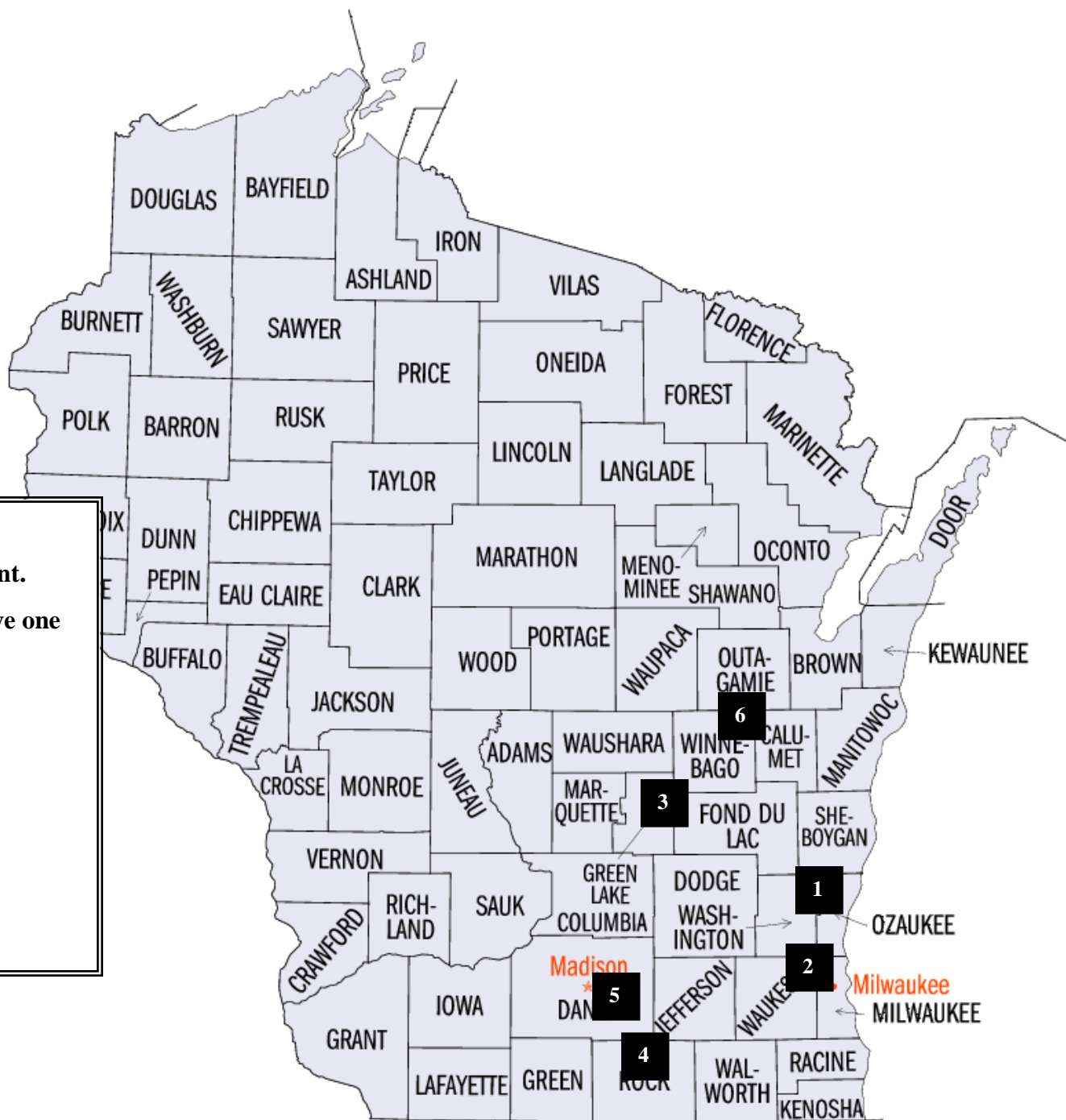

# WPGA JUNIOR FOUNDATION FUTURE CHAMPIONS TOUR RULES AND REGULATIONS

## HOW DO I ENTER?

Complete the Future Champions Tour Entry Application by following the guidelines below. **INCOMPLETE OR ILLEGIBLE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.**

## ENTRY:

\$16 per event (members) \$20 per event (non-members) must accompany entry blank. Members can also register on-line at [www.wiscjuniorgolf.com](http://www.wiscjuniorgolf.com) starting April 27. Non-members may register online starting May 12. This entry includes green fees, tee gift and awards. It is not necessary to write separate checks for each event entered and multiple entries should be mailed together.

## ELIGIBILITY:

Wisconsin residents or members of a club in the Wisconsin Section PGA, age 14 or under on the day of the tournament.

## FORMAT:

9-hole stroke play. 4 divisions as follows: Boys 12-14, Boys 11 & under, Girls 12-14, Girls 11 & under. One champion and runner-up per division. If less than four contestants in any age division, contestants will move up to the next age bracket. Age on the day of the event determines division.

**DIRECTIONS, LODGING, PAIRINGS:** Will be available on our website at [www.wiscjuniorgolf.com](http://www.wiscjuniorgolf.com) approximately one week prior to the scheduled event. Look under each individual event for information.

## DEADLINE:

Deadlines vary by event. The field will be closed at 60 players, or the event deadline, whichever comes first. Late entries will not be accepted. Entries and checks must be in the WPGA office by 5:00 p.m. the day of the deadline. MasterCard and Visa entries are allowed but incur a one time \$10 non-refundable service charge (waived for members registering on-line). In the event the tournament entry limit is met, a waiting list will be formed. You will be notified by telephone if there is a cancellation in your age group. You must be on the waiting list in order to play as an alternate.

## REFUNDS:

**NO REFUNDS** after the entry deadline. If you cancel prior to deadline a \$3 cancellation fee will be charged. If an event is cancelled in its entirety, refunds will be issued. You may cancel online using BlueGolf. If less than five holes are completed, refunds will be given on a pro-rated basis (entry less expenses.) If five or more holes are completed, awards will be given out based on participant's score against par for the holes played and no refunds will be made. Points will only be awarded for events that complete all holes.

# WPGA FUTURE CHAMPIONS TOUR RULES AND REGULATIONS

## SPECTATOR GUIDELINES:

Spectators are welcome and encouraged to attend tournaments. Rules for spectators are as follows:

1. **No spectator will be allowed to use golf cars for any reason.**
2. **Spectators are required to stay in the rough or on the cart paths and 15 yards away from the players.**
3. **Spectators are allowed to carry water, umbrellas, jackets, towels and food for the players.**
4. **Spectators are not allowed to give advice to the players. Violation will result in penalty or disqualification. Multiple violations will result in removal from future WPGA Tour Events.**
5. **Players shall not carry on conversations with spectators. This action could be construed as ADVICE. Players will be penalized for a violation.**
6. **Cell phone or similar devices use on the golf course is prohibited. First violation will result in a 2 stroke penalty for the player, the second violation will be disqualification**
7. **Players will be responsible for the actions of their spectators.**

## Player Conduct Rule:

Any conduct that may be detrimental to the Wisconsin PGA Futures Tour will not be tolerated including but not limited to swearing, club throwing, or damage to the golf course or another player's belongings. (Example: Not replacing your divot or fixing ball mark can result in breach of conduct rule). Penalty for breach of this rule is one stroke. Any major infraction may lead to two-stroke penalty or disqualification. Possession of alcohol or tobacco products, gambling, and display of vulgar or abusive behavior will result in immediate disqualification. Violations may result in removal from future events. Quitting or walking off the golf course during a round will not be tolerated. All players MUST turn in their scorecard when the round is completed.

## CELL PHONE USE:

The use of cellular phones or similar device during the play of any WPGA Junior Tour event will not be permitted. The penalty for the first violation will be 2 strokes for the player. The second violation will result in disqualification.

## RULES VIOLATIONS AND CHEATING:

Rules violations will be determined by the tournament officials and handled as prescribed by the USGA Rules of Golf, Junior Tour Director and the Executive Director of the Wisconsin PGA.

If you are suspected of cheating, measures will be taken to monitor your score during future Junior Tour events. If a player suspects another of cheating or of violating a rule of golf, the player should seek a rules official as soon as possible to handle the situation. Cheating is strictly prohibited. Cheating will result in immediate disqualification from the Junior Tour event with no refund.

## NO-CARDS

If a player leaves a tournament site and fails to turn in his/her scorecard without notifying the junior tour tournament coordinator or leaving a message in the golf shop the player will be penalized 10 points towards their player of the year point total.

## POINTS and CHAMPIONSHIP

Points will be awarded for overall finish for boys and girls for each Future Champions Event. At the conclusion of the golf season we will award a PGA Future Champion Player of the Year to the junior who has accumulated the most points. **Friday, August 19<sup>th</sup> at Vitense Golf and Country Club will be the Future Champions Championship. We will award the overall Players' of the Year at this event. Player of the Year points will only pertain to Future Champions Events. 1st Place – 50 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place – 45 points, and so on. Points at the Future Champions Championship will be based on a Junior Tour point list.**

## CARE FOR THE GOLF COURSE:

All players are expected to maintain the golf course by replacing divots, repairing ball marks, raking bunkers, etc. Any abuse to the course or other club facilities will result in immediate disqualification. **All players and parents are also encouraged to thank the host clubs staff and volunteers for their support of the WPGA Junior Tour.**
